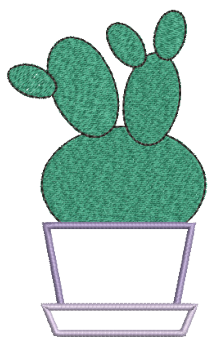

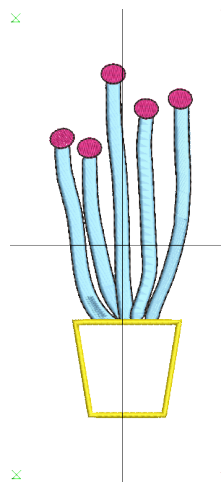
- Background fabric 65 x 45 cm

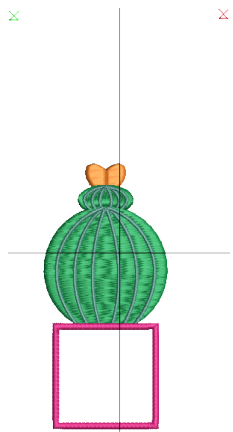

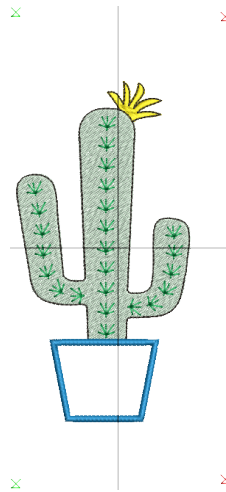

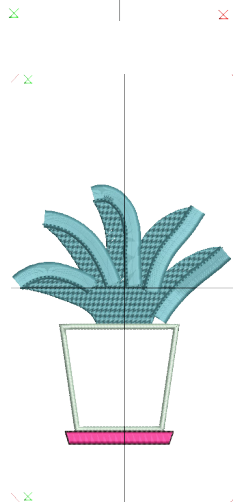

Instructions

Embroider one cactus at a time side-by-side on the fabric as per the marked crosses, creating the flowerpots as an appliqué.

On the right-hand cactus (6745_Cactus_Applique-05), cut through the lower thread of the satin stitches on the entire line. Carefully pull upper thread forward and out.

Cut fabric straight, pull around the hoop and staple or glue in place.
